I predominantly work with slip cast porcelain exploring themes of gender and the domestic experience through the subversion of familiar household objects. Using the affordances of objects and recoding them from function to dysfunction.

For this exhibition, however, I decided to diverge from my usual work to combine my love of tea and snacks. I wanted to create a more functional art object in which the user can allow themselves to take a moment to just enjoy.

Alicia is an emerging ceramic artist based in Canberra. She has recently graduated from the Australian National University School of Art & Design with a Bachelor of Visual Art majoring in ceramics.

In 2023, she was selected as a finalist for *STILL: National Still Life Award*. She has exhibited in group shows including: *Threads of Being*, Canberra Potters Society, Watson, ACT; *Small Works Art Prize*, Brunswick Street Gallery, Fitzroy, VIC; Canberra Potters Society Members Exhibitions, and *tada* Kyoto Art Hostel Kumagusuku, Kyoto, Japan.
